- How you think and behave shapes your character.

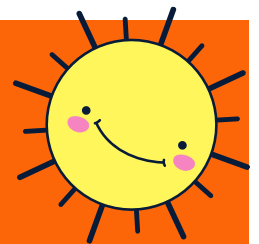
Reflect on the quote and meaning. How will you show your **character in art** this week?

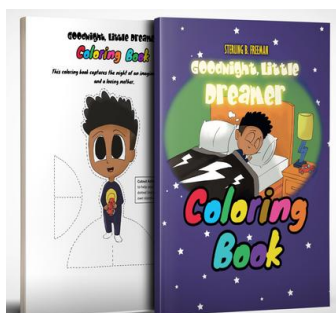
